PRAY Ask God to be a person who adds value the people around you, and also ask God to surround you with people who promote excellence in your life.

Ask God, believing that He has power to provide everything. Analyze if you have put any physical impediment as an excuse, remember that God can also provide so that this does not be an excuse

Analyze and write a list if there are other people's errors or injustices that you have lived that you have put as an excuse not to do things with excellence. Ask God that faith and effort help you get over yourself.
20	Friday, February 17th	BE BRAVE!	Can any fear stop?	MATTHEW 25 25 So I was afraid and went out and hid your gold in the ground. See, here is what belongs to you.'	Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you if it exists some fear that instead of putting the talents that God has given you, you have decided bury them. After identifying them, ask him to help beat them.
